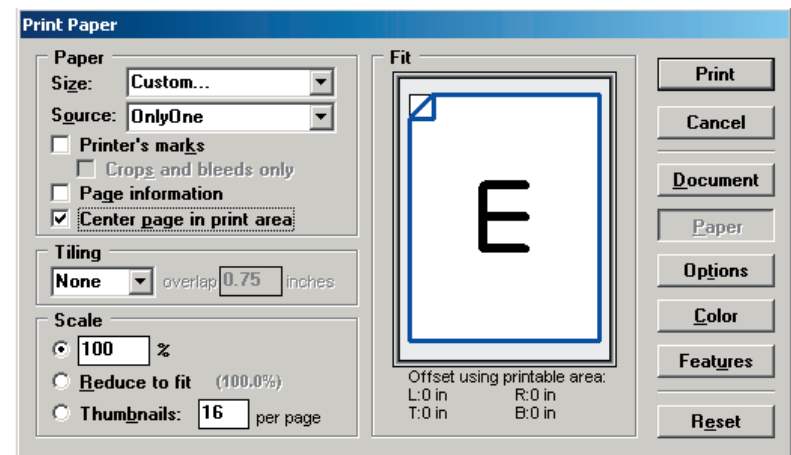


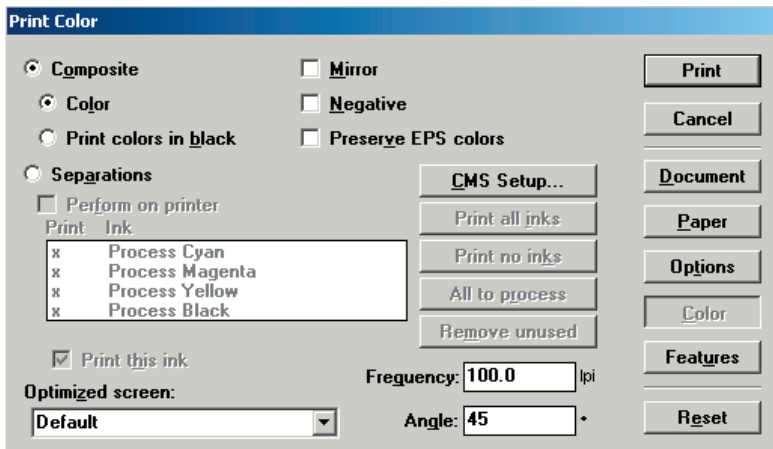

1. Choose File>Print from your Pagemaker toolbar
2. In the top drop down menu for "Printer" choose a Postscript printer. If you do not have one available, you can download one from our website:  
[http://www.oregonwebpress.com/drivers\\_ppds.html](http://www.oregonwebpress.com/drivers_ppds.html)
3. If you do not install our PPD listed above from our website (see #2 above), you should use the PDF PPD that comes with Pagemaker.
4. Choose your page range.
5. Verify your page orientation.
6. Click the "Paper" button to the right.

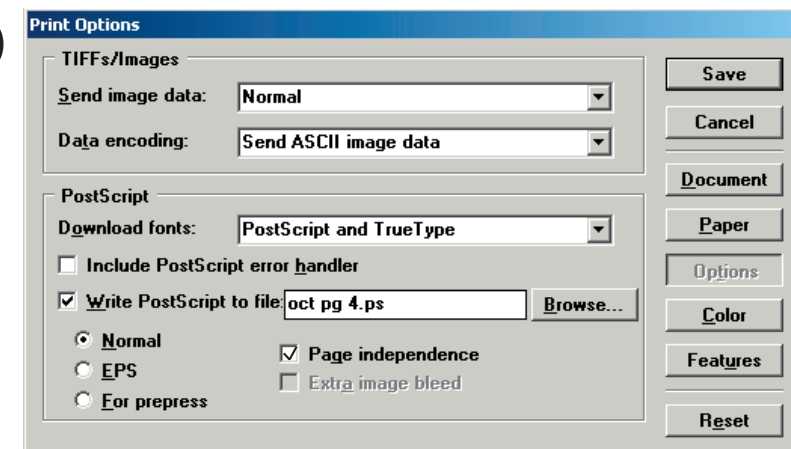
7. In the top drop down menu for "Size" choose "Custom". It should come up with your documents page dimensions automatically.
8. Check "Center page in print area".
9. Verify the scale is set to 100%.
10. Click the "Color" button to the right.

11. Choose "Composite". If available, choose "Color" below it. This option may not be available if you did not choose a color PPD in step 1.
12. Leave the rest of the options as the were default.
13. Choose the "Options" button to the right.

14. In the top drop down menu for "Send image data" choose "Normal".
15. Check the box next to "Write Postscript to file. Notice that the "Print" button changes to a "Save" button.
16. Give the Postscript file a name.
17. Click the "Browse" button to choose the location to save the file.
18. Check "Page independence" and click the "Save" button.
